Instructions

- All of the items on the above checklist need to be in the PAL office by **3pm on May 3, 2010**. **No exceptions.**
- **Who can apply:** Current PAL members who are high school seniors with a minimum GPA of 2.0 and PAL alumni currently in college with at least a 2.5 GPA.
- Fill out the form **COMPLETELY** in ink or on a computer (you can download the application from www.hollywoodpal.org). Neatness, brevity and legibility are desired. If more space is needed, use the back of the application.
- The financial need response should be no more than 200 words and should be written by your parent or guardian. This is an opportunity for them to explain how much they will be able to financially contribute to your education and bring to our attention any additional financial burdens that are not otherwise addressed on the application. (Examples: Death in the family, sick, elderly, handicapped relatives living in the home, a parent who is incarcerated)
- We expect that you write your essay in a clear, concise manner. There is not a page or word restriction, however a longer essay does not mean it will be a good essay. Answer the question completely and to the best of your ability. A typed essay is preferred, however if it is hand written, it must be in ink and legible.
- All answers and information provided to us are considered confidential.
